Pastoral Sabbatical Policy

On Monday, August 10, Ivan and Pam will begin a four month sabbatical until Sunday, December 13, for refreshment during this pastoral transition year. They plan to begin this time by turning off their cell phones and spending two weeks disconnecting from their responsibilities at our church that have preoccupied their minds for the past ten years. Following that time they plan to spend time with Kaitlyn and Josiah in Nevada and Utah before spending several weeks in Montana. Later they plan to return to Belleville to prepare to re-enter before Ivan becomes Senior Pastor on January 31, 2021.

Listed below is a copy of our Sabbatical Policy which was first written for Max's six month sabbatical Jan – June, 2008 and will be guiding Ivan & Pam.

Pastor's Sabbatical Policy Approved May 1, 2006

Purposes of the Sabbatical:

- 1. To encourage growth and refreshment in the ministry
- 2. To increase the likelihood of longer pastoral tenure
- 3. To provide an opportunity for professional learning and development.

Guidelines:

- 1. One month of sabbatical time is earned for two years of pastoral service rendered (or two weeks for every year of service) for a maximum of six months sabbatical time, eligible after five years of service.
- 2. The sabbatical time may be spent in study, short term mission project, teaching, travel, or other growth and refreshment related activity.
- 3. The specific proposal must be presented by October for the following calendar year, and is subject to the approval of the elders and finance committee.
- 4. Financial reimbursement will be between 50% and 100% of regular salary and benefits, depending upon the nature of the sabbatical activity, and any remuneration received from other sources.
- 5. Following a sabbatical the pastor agrees to provide a minimum of one year of service to the congregation with the understanding that repayment of sabbatical salary and benefits will be made for failure to do so.
